DRESS CODE

Summer is still here and a reminder for students to follow the dress code. Here is the policy:

- 1) Any clothing that contains vulgar or obscene slogans or pictures as well as any clothing that advertises any alcohol, tobacco, or illegal drug is prohibited.
- 2) Hats/bandanas are not to be worn inside the building without prior permission from administration.
- 3) Pants must be worn properly around the waist (no under garments showing). Pants may not contain rips or tears above the knee level unless rip has appropriate undergarment. All shorts and skirts must be at a minimum of a fingertip length when the arm is extended at the side of the student.
- 4) All shirts must be able to touch the top of the pants. Strapless shirts and low-cut, spaghetti tops are prohibited.
- 5) Excessive amounts of chains or jewelry, which may cause safety concerns for the student or other students, will not be allowed.
