Welcome to Ohio County Elementary Middle School (OCEMS). Please find a classroom supply list and your child's teacher for the upcoming year. We are excited for the 2019 – 2020 school year. Please find below a few quick bullet points to remember as we get closer to August.

- ♦ Open House will be held on Thursday, August 1, 2019 from 6:00 − 8:00 p.m. We encourage you to bring your classroom supplies, meet the teacher and see the classroom/building.
- ♦ Bookstore hours will begin on Tuesday, July 30 from 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. @ RSHS Room 2010. The Bookstore will be open on July 31 from 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. @ RSHS Room 2010 and open on Thursday, August 1 from 12:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. in the OCEMS gym.
- ♦ OCEMS offers early drop off hours at no cost starting at 6:45 a.m. to assist parents/guardians getting to work early. Students will watch a movie with other classmates in the cafeteria while being supervised by staff members. Students can be dropped off in front of the OCEMS building.
- ◆ Latchkey services will be provided from 3:00 5:30 p.m. and transportation will be provided for students if desired. Latchkey services are provided for students Preschool through 6th grade. Students will have an extra recess, homework help, academic extension, remediation and snack time.
- ◆ Breakfast fees will be \$1.25. Lunch fees for the 2019 2020 school year will be \$2.55 for K 2 students and \$2.75 for students in 3rd 8th grades.
- ◆ Volunteers are an important part of our school ranging from holiday parties to field trips. If you are interested in volunteering, a personal background check must be completed and on file. Background check forms will be available in your Open House folder. A new form needs to be submitted annually.

Our staff looks forward to the start of the 2019 – 2020 school year. We hope that you enjoy your summer, get rejuvenated, and are excited to come back to school on Friday, August 2, 2019.




