INTERNATIONAL TRIP NEWS

If you plan to take your phone on the trip please get your # to Ms. Baker ASAP as the office wants it on file in case of emergency while we are abroad. Also tip money needs to be to Ms. Baker by Friday March 16. In addition we received word back from EF and unfortunately we are required to pay \$25 for a checked bag 40lbs or under, it is \$50 if you are over this amount so weigh your bag before you get to the airport!!!! You could save yourself some money by not checking a bag and taking a carry on. You are allowed 1 carry on suitcase and 1 bag (purse, backpack, etc.). All carry on suitcase must meet the dimensions set by the airport. Please make sure you look at the rules regarding liquids on board, they will not be allowed on if they do not meet code! Talk to Seip or Baker if you have any questions or concerns. We can always purchase things like bug spray, sunscreen, and contact solution when we arrive. Remember to talk to teachers about missed days!!!!!! Stay up to date on assignments!!!!!!

If you are taking your cell phone to Costa Rica please make sure you give Ms. Baker your cell number ASAP as the office needs it for emergency purposes.

We will be flying out of CVG at **11:25 am on 3/21**. We will need to arrive at the airport well in advance of our departure time, we will discuss this as well as much more at the upcoming meeting.
