

Kindergarten Roundup

It's that time again. Time to get your child ready to start school. Parents can register their child to start kindergarten for the 2010-2011 school year on Friday, April 23rd, from 4-6 pm or Saturday, April 24th, from 10-12. You only need to attend one day. You will complete enrollment forms, receive important information, and complete health screenings. There will be no academic testing this year.

A pre-kindergarten physical exam is required. There will be a doctor here to do physicals at no cost. If you wish to take advantage of this opportunity, you must call for an appointment.

Parents and students will be able to tour the building and visit the kindergarten classrooms. Hearing and vision screenings will be completed by Jamie Works, School Nurse and Regina Crouch, Ohio County Health Nurse. You will also have the opportunity to schedule appointments with Ohio County Health Department to complete required immunizations.

An original copy of your child's birth certificate and a copy of your child's immunization record is required for registration. Both must be on file before your child can attend school in the fall. The birth certificate should be the one issued from the county in which your child was born.
CHILDREN MUST BE FIVE YEARS OF AGE BY AUGUST 1, 2010 IN ORDER TO ATTEND KINDERGARTEN IN THE FALL.
